### FROM RUNWAY TO SKY: TURNING VISION INTO FLIGHT

According to Forbes, around 90% of startups fail, with 10% failing within the first year. As Guy Kawasaki wisely put it, "The hardest thing about getting started is getting started." You may carry a powerful vision, but stepping out, taking off is often the hardest part. A University of Scranton study also found that while 92% of people set goals and dreams, only 8% actually achieve them. The waters look too deep, the storms feel too fierce, the purpose seems too heavy to lift and our own backgrounds keep us stuck on the runway.

Yet when we open the Bible, we see story after story of ordinary people who dared to launch not into shallow, safe places, but right into the deep, where faith was their only anchor, and the skies were their destination.

Think of Noah. God told him to build an ark, something no one had ever seen, in a world that had never known rain. People must have laughed and doubted, but Noah kept building, plank by plank, year after year. He launched into the unseen, trusting God more than the voices around him.

Then there's Abraham. God called him to leave his home, family, and everything familiar to go to a land He would show him. No map, no itinerary, just a promise. Yet the Bible simply says, "So Abram went..." That's faith: stepping out before you see where the path leads.

Or Moses. At eighty years old, burdened by past mistakes and feeling unqualified, God called him to confront Pharaoh and lead a nation to freedom. Imagine the fear and sense of inadequacy but Moses still launched into the impossible, trusting God to do what he couldn't.

Joshua faced giants and fortified cities after Moses' death. His strength wasn't in numbers but in God's promise: "Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." Joshua took off into a future that seemed impossible, anchored by that promise.

Gideon, the least in his family, was called to save Israel. God reduced his army from 32,000 to just 300 men against countless enemies. Talk about launching against overwhelming odds! Yet Gideon obeyed, and God turned the impossible into victory.

Queen Esther teaches us that sometimes launching isn't about starting something new, but risking everything we already have. Facing genocide against her people, she declared, "If I perish, I perish," and stepped into the king's court uninvited, choosing destiny over comfort.

And then there's Peter. In the middle of a stormy night, Jesus said, "Come." Peter stepped out of the boat, leaving what felt secure and walked on water by faith. Even when fear made him sink, his willingness to step out remains one of the most powerful pictures of faith in action.

Friend, God never calls us to stay in the shallow waters of comfort and predictability. The deep places; the skies, the unknown, the uncomfortable, the seemingly impossible are where purpose truly comes alive. Maybe God is calling you to start a business, write a book, serve your community, share your faith, or take a bold step toward your calling. And maybe it feels scary, uncertain, or even absurd. But remember: every great takeoff begins with a single step of faith not a perfect plan.

### DARE TO TAKEOFF

### FIVE FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLES FOR LAUNCHING YOUR PURPOSE

Arisers, dreams don't just take flight on their own, they need courage to lift off. Too often, we let doubt keep our purpose grounded, stuck on the runway gathering dust. But remember this: God didn't place that dream in your heart to tease you; He put it there because He has a plan to bring it to life! It's time to move beyond wishing and start doing. To guide us, we'll look to Jesus; the perfect example of what it takes to launch into purpose and stay the course. Some of us have rushed into takeoff too soon and found ourselves crashing or stalling midair. That's why a strong foundation is so important, it shapes how high you can soar and determines the destinations you'll reach. In this journey, I'm going to share five powerful, biblical principles that will help you take off with confidence and soar, because you were made for the skies!

### 1. IDENTITY AFFIRMATION

Before Jesus ever preached a sermon, performed a miracle, or gathered followers, He received divine affirmation at His baptism: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." (Matthew 3:17). Friend, knowing who you are and whose you are is the foundation for everything else. When you know you're a child of the Most High God, you won't be shaken by what others say or by the storms of life. Too many young people today struggle with identity confusion. That confusion breeds anxiety, low self-esteem, and poor decisions. But Scripture says: "The people that do know their God shall be strong and do exploits." (Daniel 11:32). Before you take off, settle this in your heart: You are chosen, loved, and called for a purpose.

### 2. PREPARATION IN THE WILDERNESS

When God gives you a vision, it's exciting but don't mistake vision for immediate release. Even Jesus, after receiving His calling, spent 40 days in the wilderness praying and fasting (Luke 4:1–2). That season wasn't wasted. It was a time to strengthen His spirit, sharpen His focus, and prepare for the challenges ahead. Friend, maybe right now you're in a hidden place; preparing, studying, praying, planning. Don't rush it. God uses those seasons to build your character so your destiny won't crumble under pressure. Remember: When preparation meets opportunity, success is no longer a matter of chance.

### 3. DEPENDENCE ON THE WORD

When Jesus faced temptation, He didn't argue with the enemy or rely on His own strength. He simply said: "It is written..." (Matthew 4:4,7,10). The Word of God isn't just a book; it's your foundation, your anchor, your weapon. Everything God creates, He speaks into being. And the same goes for your purpose. Friend, root your vision in Scripture. Stand on His promises. When challenges come and they will; it's His Word that will keep you steady and move you forward.




### 4. EMPOWERMENT BY THE SPIRIT

Jesus' disciples walked with Him, learned from Him, saw miracles for over three years. Yet He told them not to start their ministry until they received power from the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:4–8). After His wilderness season, Jesus returned "in the power of the Spirit" (Luke 4:14). Friend, your gifts and talents are wonderful, but lasting impact comes when you're empowered by God's Spirit. Pray daily, "Holy Spirit, guide me, strengthen me, anoint me for what You've called me to do." That power turns ordinary efforts into extraordinary impact.

#### 5. ALIGNMENT WITH KINGDOM PURPOSE

At the start of His ministry, Jesus declared His mission boldly: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me... to preach good news... to set the oppressed free..." (Luke 4:18–19). His purpose wasn't just about Himself; it was about serving, healing, and restoring others. Friend, when your vision is aligned with something bigger than you, when it's about building God's Kingdom and blessing people; you unlock favor, provision, and breakthroughs you could never achieve on your own. "Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." (Matthew 6:33)

Don't let your vision stay trapped in your mind. Step out in faith. Trust that God, who gave you the dream, will also give you the strength, wisdom, and provision to see it through. Affirm who you are in Christ, Prepare in the hidden place, Stand on His Word, Seek the Spirit's power and Align your purpose with God's Kingdom. Friend, the takeoff may seem scary. ### BLESSING BANDA: THE UNLIKELY PATH TO PURPOSE.

Blessing Banda's journey is a powerful testament to the fact that where you come from does not have to dictate where you are going. It is a story of faith, resilience, and the relentless pursuit of a dream, all woven into the fabric of her professional achievements as "The Legal Host."

Growing up in Chipata Compound, a place where teenage pregnancies, drug abuse, and child marriages were common, Blessing was a girl with a burning question: "How can I change my story?" Her father's death had forced her family to relocate, and she was acutely aware of the social pressures around her. But with the unwavering support of her mother and grandmother, she excelled academically, graduating from St. Paul's Secondary School with flying colors.

Despite her initial success, the path forward was filled with roadblocks. A promising scholarship to study abroad fell through due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Then, a glimmer of hope appeared when an organization promised to sponsor her at the University of Zambia (UNZA). For four months, everything seemed perfect, but her hopes were shattered when she discovered the organization had never even registered her. The funders had pulled out, and Blessing was left feeling like a failure, questioning her faith and her future.

Defeated and depressed, Blessing lost all hope of ever returning to school. But a friend from her church wouldn't let her give up. He encouraged her to apply for a scholarship at Cavendish University Zambia, a suggestion she initially dismissed. She had been offered a 50% scholarship from them before, which was only valid for one semester, and she had no faith that this time would be any different. She had, as she now reflects, "limited God."

However, a few weeks later, a strong conviction led her to try again. This time, her journey to the aptitude test was another challenge. She arrived two hours late after getting lost, and with only 30 minutes to complete a two-hour exam, she felt defeated before she even began. She left the exam room certain she had failed, but her story was far from over.



One Wednesday afternoon, a direct message on her phone changed everything. It was a message of congratulations; Blessing Banda had been awarded a 100% scholarship to study law. She was in shock. How could she have received a full scholarship after writing only a fraction of a competitive exam?

At just 22 years old, Blessing, affectionately known as "The Legal Host," is a dynamic force making waves across Zambia and beyond. As a multi-talented corporate events host, personal branding trainer, and law graduate, she is redefining what it means to be a young achiever. While her story of academic resilience is a testament to her unwavering faith, her professional portfolio is a masterclass in turning potential into purpose.

Blessing has leveraged her expertise in communication and personal branding to create impactful, lasting events. She has commanded some of the most prominent stages in the region, from moderating a legal session at the Ministry of Youth's National Youth Week to hosting the International Youth Summit on Land Reforms and Economic Liberation in Harare, Zimbabwe. Her work has even earned her an opportunity to meet the President of Zimbabwe.

But Blessing's influence extends far beyond the stage. Through her capacity-building sessions, she empowers individuals and start-up organizations with the practical skills needed to thrive professionally. Her dedication is also evident in her leadership roles, having served as the first-ever female Law Faculty President at Cavendish University and as a volunteer for various community organizations.

Her exceptional work has not gone unnoticed. Blessing has been honored with the Rising Star of the Year 2024 award and was profiled as a "Woman to Watch" by the Zambia Daily Mail. She was also recognized as one of the 100 African women making a significant positive impact. These accolades are a reflection of her dedication and purpose-driven life.

Blessing Banda's journey is a powerful message to all young people that your past does not have to limit your future. It's not about where you start, but about the relentless discipline, faith, and hard work you invest in where you're going. Her message is clear: Don't limit God. ### STAND OUT, SHOW UP, SUCCEED BY BLESSING BANDA

My story is living proof of this truth. As a student at Cavendish University, I refused to sit quietly in the background. I dared to step forward, to lead, and eventually became the first-ever female president of the Law Faculty. That moment wasn't just a personal victory, it was a reminder that no one is coming to save you. You must reminder that no one is coming to save you. You must be your own hero.

#### **CHOOSING TO STAND OUT**

To the young people reading this, I want you to know this: greatness belongs to those who stand out. It's easy to blend into the crowd, but history is written by those who dare to be different. Fear will always show up at the edge of something extraordinary. Don't let it stop you, let it guide you. I started small. My journey in public speaking and event hosting began in 2022. My first corporate event wasn't perfect but it was a start. Since then, I have hosted more than 50 events. That growth didn't come by luck. It came through hard work, listening to mentors, reading widely, and practicing until light better. practicing until I got better.

#### **LESSONS LEARNED**

Through my journey, I've learned that success isn't just about hard work, it's about showing up right. Show up prepared. Show up authentic. Show up with excellence. When preparation meets opportunity, success is not just possible, it's inevitable. Never let your background limit your future. You may not choose where you were born, but you can choose who you become If you cannot yet create the future. who you become. If you cannot yet create the future you want, then start by creating yourself for the future. Posițion yourself so that when destiny calls, you are ready.

- **Process your pain:** Don't bury your feelings. Blessing admitted to feeling shattered by failure, but she found the grace to pull through. Healing starts with acknowledging the pain.
- **Refuse to be a victim:** She could have remained in self-pity, but Blessing chose to rise, rewrite her narrative, and try again. That's strength.
- **Don't limit God's power:** At one point, she lost hope and nearly missed applying for the Cavendish scholarship, underestimating what God could do. Remember, He can make a way where none seems to exist.
- **Take a risk, even in doubt:** With little faith but deep conviction, Blessing still applied and sat for the test. Sometimes obedience comes before belief; courage is acting even when your feelings don't align.
- **Turn disadvantage into character:** Arriving two hours late for an exam should have disqualified her. Instead, it became a testament to her determination. Your setbacks can transform into your strongest testimonies.
- **Resilience will be rewarded:** Every time Blessing refused to quit, she was planting seeds. The harvest came in the form of a 100% scholarship. Perseverance always bears fruit.
- Your story is for others: Her testimony is not just hers, it uplifts countless youths who now know that triumph is possible. Your life, too, is a light for others.
- **Be open to divine redirection:** The path she thought was hers, international studies or UNZA; closed. Yet God redirected her toward a better plan. Trust His rerouting.
- Live to prove the odds wrong: Blessing is a living contradiction to statistics and societal expectations. She shows that your environment does not dictate your destiny.

NAVIGATION: KNOW WHERE YOU'RE


