


6. HAVE THE COURAGE TO LEAD

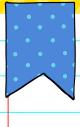

There are women who walk into the spotlight, and there are women who carry the spotlight within them. Happy Simelane, lovingly known as Her Majesty, is one of those rare souls whose presence commands attention not because of glamour alone, but because of the unshakable story she carries in her heart. She is a woman of many crowns: entrepreneur, executive producer, philanthropist, author, speaker, and reality TV star. But perhaps her greatest crown is one invisible to the eye, the crown of resilience.

Faith without action stays grounded; purpose only lifts off when effort meets grace.


LIFT: THE POWER OF FAITH

5. Human Capital



A proud graduate of the University of Zambia with a degree in Environmental Education and Management, Dalitso is currently pursuing her Master's in Climate Change and Sustainability Education. She now serves as the Youth and Children Program Coordinator at the Center for Environment Justice (CEJ), where she manages multiple projects that place children and youth at the center of climate solutions. Beyond this, she wears many hats: Board Member of Know Your Wildlife and the Environment Zambia, Vice Coordinator of the Zambia Environmental Youth Network, and Youth Panelist on the Global Youth Mobilization Fund under the European Union.

Her journey has been nothing short of remarkable. With over 40 certifications and recognitions from prestigious institutions, including Cambridge University, Dalitso embodies the spirit of a lifelong learner. She previously led the Voices for Just Climate Action Project at CUTS International and has been a trailblazer since her university days, serving as Minister of Education and Academic Affairs in the University of Zambia Student Union, among other leadership roles. She also championed political participation as the Tertiary Lead for the Girls Gone Political movement and is an alumna of the Nairobi Summer School on Climate Justice, YALI, and World Change Agents YMCA.

In fact, if people laugh at you, call you "deputy Jesus" or "holier than thou" because you refuse to compromise God's Word, it's a badge of honor! It means your light is shining so brightly that it exposes and offends the darkness around you. Remember, light doesn't ask permission to shine, it simply does.

So, let them talk. Let them call you names. Never bow to the pressure of fitting in. Never trade purity for popularity. Truth will always outlast lies, and righteousness will always speak louder than compromise. Jesus Himself declared: "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven." (Matthew 5:11–12).

Young people, this is our generation's call: to stand tall when others bow low, to remain holy when the crowd chooses compromise, and to rejoice when the world misunderstands us. The kingdom of God is not for the faint-hearted; it is for those who dare to be different. Your uncompromising faith will inspire many, even generations to come.

So rise. Stand firm. Shine bright. The glory of God rests on those who will not mix the sacred with the profane.
