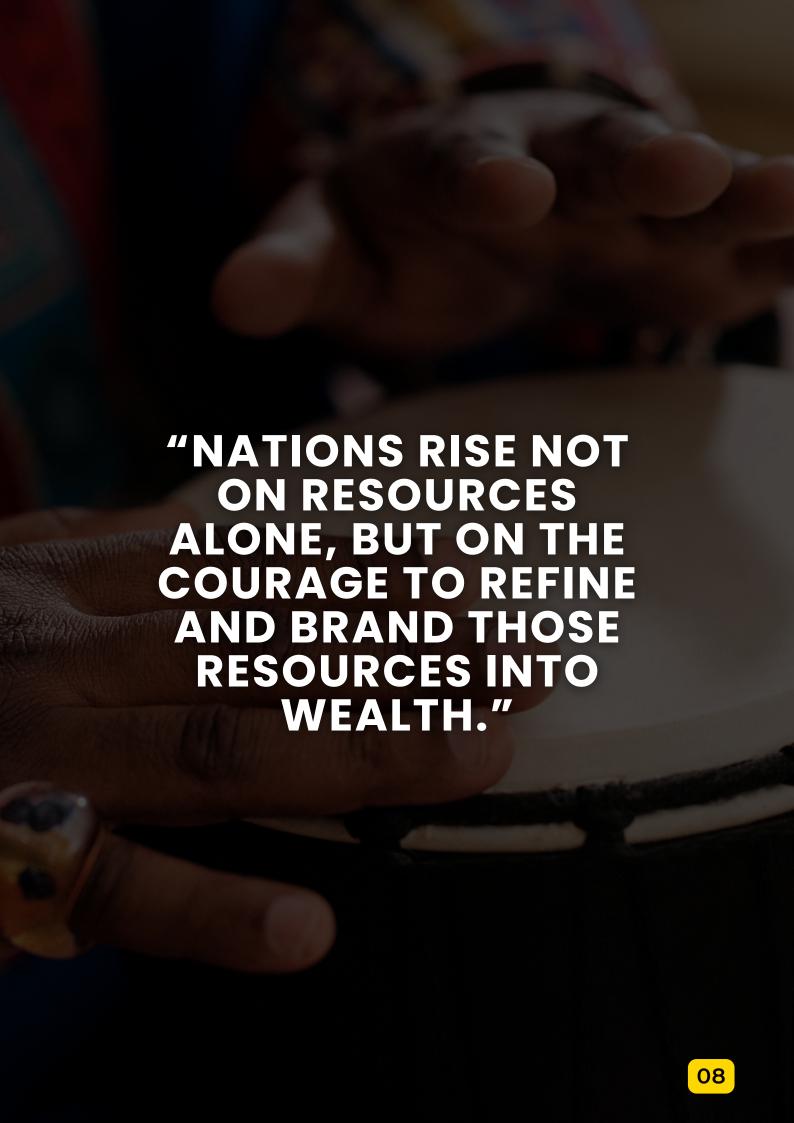
Step 6: Add Value Everywhere You Go

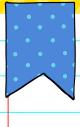

Felistus Nya-Uyu Ngwira is not just a comedian, she is a movement. Renowned across Malawi and beyond as the "Queen of Vilekeke Queendom," she has mastered the art of using humor as both a mirror and a megaphone, reflecting society's truths while amplifying messages of hope, culture, and transformation.

From her early days of creating comedy skits around 2010, Nya-Uyu has risen to become a household name, blending entertainment with cultural advocacy in a way that resonates deeply with audiences across Africa. Whether performing in Chichewa, English, or Tumbuka, she has broken barriers and carved a space where laughter and learning walk hand in hand. Her unique ability to tackle complex social issues with wit has not only entertained but also inspired change in countless lives.

Her influence stretches far beyond comedy. A seasoned actress, MC, planner, lawyer, and event personality, international media Nya-Uyu is a woman of many talents. She has worked in radio, engaged thousands through YouTube, Facebook, and X, and has earned recognition international platforms such as BBC Focus on Africa. Yet behind all her achievements lies a central mission: to use creativity as a tool for transformation.



True to her trailblazing spirit, Nya-Uyu has also achieved historic firsts that cement her as a cultural pioneer. She is the first comedian in Malawi to launch a podcast with great influence, featuring diverse guests and voices of national importance. With over 523,000 followers on Facebook, the largest for any female comedian in Malawi, her impact is not only visible but measurable in the feedback, testimonies, and lives changed through her work.

Let's make depression and suicide a conversation not a secret. Let's build a world where struggling is not shameful and asking for help is brave.



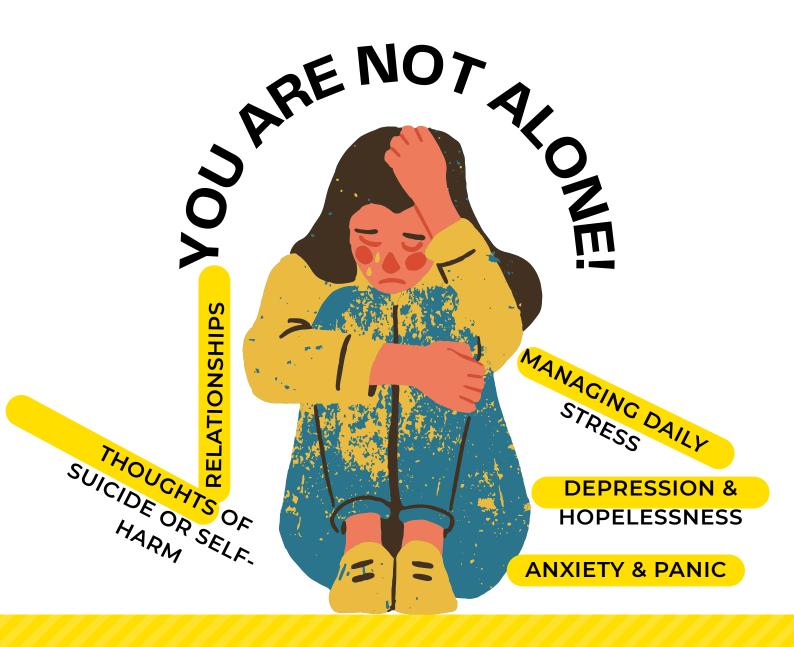

FAITH IN EVERY NOTE: MIRIAM'S GOSPEL MISSION.

AMBASSADOR OF THE WEEK

When you encounter Miriam Shekainah Kawangu, you quickly realize she is more than a singer, she is a vessel of the gospel, a believer whose ministry flows through melody. Her voice is not just music, it is a message; not just performance, but purpose. Through every song, Miriam preaches Jesus with power and draws hearts to the cross.

Raised in a Christian home, Miriam's foundation was laid early. Her parents, with steadfast faith, guided her toward Christ and nurtured her walk with God. Her father, Mr. Fickson Kawangu, ensured the family was given all that was possible; values, faith, and love that would anchor Miriam's life and ministry. It is within this environment of faith and devotion that her gift began to blossom, grounded in the truth of the gospel.

Her journey into music began in 2013, while still in Grade 9, when a spark was lit that would never be extinguished. What started as a simple passion soon became a calling. By 2016, Miriam had joined the celebrated Kings Malembe Malembe Band, a platform that sharpened her gift, stretched her capacity, and placed her in spaces where she could grow both as an artist and as a minister. Parallel to her music, she pursued a professional career in Occupational Health, proving that her strength lay not just in talent but in discipline and balance.

The path, however, was not without challenges. Like many who carry greatness, Miriam battled performance anxiety, the weight of standing on big platforms, and the fatigue of burnout. She learned firsthand that working with people is never easy, it requires patience, resilience, and a strong personality. Criticism came, as it does to anyone who dares to shine, but instead of breaking her, it built her. The struggle to guard her mental health, to balance personal life, academics, and ministry, became her training ground. Every obstacle forged her into a woman of substance; resilient, patient, and deeply anchored in God.

Her growth has been marked by bold steps of faith. She released her debut single, **Mwandabula**, meaning Rewarding, a song that echoes her testimony: that those who remain faithful to God will never be forgotten. It was not just a song, it was a declaration that her ministry was only beginning.
